Administrative & Biographical History	Br Anthony (1836-1906) was born Michael O'Neill at Ballinastraw, Tullow, Co. Carlow. He was educated at St Patrick's Seminary, Tullow, and Patrician Brothers' College, Mountrath, Co. Laois. He entered the Patrician Brothers in 1857. He served as Assistant General between 1888-1893 and 1899-1906, and as Superior General between 1893-1899. At various times, he was a member of the communities at Tullow, Mountrath, Galway and Fethard, and served as a teacher. Br Anthony died on 6 August 1906.
